Marching Classic

- The Royse City Marching Classic will be held October 14, 2017.
- Band Competition will 1-4pm with 7pm-Finals
- There will be 10 bands competing this first year.
- Tickets: \$10-Adults, \$5-12 and Under, Senior Citizens-RC Gold Card will be accepted
- Earning Opportunities: Ticket Sales, Concessions, Shout-Outs
- Volunteer opportunities will be publicized through Sign-Up Genius with Student and Parent Sections being designated to ensure proper assignment.
- Attendance will consist of 1,300-1,500 competing band students plus parents and family members.
- Parking: A shuttle may have to be set up at Fort, this is being looked into and a decision will be made at a closer time as to if it is needed.
- Warm up areas will be designated according to Battery and Front Ensemble.
- Pepwear will be in attendance with shirts, etc.
- For the areas the Band Boosters will be accepting money, Credit Cards will be accepted for tickets on the day of the event, Only Cash will be accepted at the Concession Stand
- Mr. Fulwood is gearing the Marching Classic to be more 'Service Oriented' so that each competing band gets a usable critique to help the band be better prepared for their UIL performance.
- Judges: Music- 3, Visual-2
- Concessions: Looking at the possibility of a 'Drink-Only' option if the crowd dictates.
- Expenses for the event: Custodian, Security, Trophies, Digital Recorders, Wrist Bands, Concession Items
- Meal Plan: Competing Bands will be offered a Meal Plan opportunity from Jason's Deli or Pizza Hut to ensure their band has a convenient and guaranteed meal for their students
